



Accommodation Options

Kolora offers a single room type, with all 32 rooms designed to provide privacy, safety and a sense of comfort and belonging. Every room is well-appointed and close to shared lounge areas and secure garden spaces, encouraging both relaxation and connection.

Accommodation Pricing

Your aged care fees are determined based on your personal financial circumstances. The Department of Human Services will assess your income and assets to determine what you may be required to pay. You may be asked to contribute to one or more of the following:

- 1. Basic Daily Fee: This fee covers day-to-day living costs such as meals, power, and laundry. For many residents, this is the only fee they are required to pay.
- 2. Means Tested Care Fee: An additional contribution towards the cost of care, this fee applies to some residents based on the outcome of their income and asset assessment. The Department of Human Services will notify you if this applies to you and how much you are required to pay.
- 3. Accommodation Payment: This fee covers the cost of your accommodation at Kolora. Some residents may have their accommodation costs partially or fully paid by the Australian Government. Others will be required to contribute, depending on their assessed financial position.

The maximum accommodation payment for any room type at McLean Care Kolora is \$440,000.

Payment Options

There are several ways to pay for your accommodation. You can choose the option that best suits your financial situation:

- Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD):
 A lump sum payment of up to \$440,000
- Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP): A daily payment calculated based on the current interest rate
- Combination Payment: A mix of RAD and DAP. For example:
 - 50% RAD (\$220,000) + 50% DAP (\$46.89 per day)
- RAD with Drawdown: For example, a RAD of \$220,000 with a daily drawdown equivalent to \$46.89 in DAP charges, calculated at an interest rate of 7.78% per annum

Note: The Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) is calculated using the Maximum Permissible Interest Rate (MPIR) set by the government. As of July 2025, the MPIR is 7.78% per annum, but this rate is updated quarterly. Please visit the Australian Government Department of Health website for the most current rates.

You may pay your accommodation as:

- A full RAD (lump sum)
- A full DAP (daily payment, billed monthly)
- A combination of both
- A drawdown from the RAD to cover DAP costs

If you move to a different room within the facility, your Residential Care Agreement will be updated to reflect the pricing of the new room. The Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) will be recalculated using the Maximum Permissible Interest Rate (MPIR) that applies on the date of your updated agreement.
