Accommodation Options

At Killean, we offer a wide range of room types across six accommodation wings. Each room is designed to provide privacy, comfort, and safety, with access to shared gardens, lounge areas, and peaceful community spaces.

Argyll Centre - Single Room with Shared Ensuite (~17.95m²)

A light-filled and spacious room for one, with access to a shared ensuite.

Room features:

- Bedside drawers, built-in wardrobe, fitted shelving
- Shared ensuite with toilet, shower and vanity
- Evaporative cooling and heating

Argyll Centre - Shared Room with Shared Ensuite (~30.6m²)

Designed for two residents, this large room encourages social connection while maintaining privacy and comfort.

Room features:

- Shared ensuite with full amenities
- Generous space with two sets of furnishings
- Evaporative cooling and heating

Beresford Coward Hostel - Single Room with Private Ensuite (~22.7m²)

Each room has a private ensuite and kitchenette. Residents can bring their own furniture, creating a home-like feel.

Room features:

- Kitchenette and large wardrobe
- Medical-grade bed and soft furnishings
- Ensuite with grab rails and modern fittings
- Access to communal lounges, dining spaces, and garden areas

Chisholm Wing - Single Room with Shared Ensuite (~12.5m²)

- Close to lounge with television

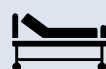

Hector Wing - Single Room with Private Ensuite (~23m²)

Spacious, modern and comfortable, these rooms offer enhanced privacy and access to beautifully maintained communal areas.

Room features:

- Internal wardrobe LED lighting, fitted shelving
- Private ensuite with contemporary finishes
- Access to large lounge, library, internal courtyard and patio

Accommodation Pricing

Your aged care fees are determined by your individual financial circumstances. The Department of Human Services (DHS) assesses your income and assets to determine what you may need to contribute. You may be asked to pay one or more of the following fees:



Basic Daily Care Fee (BDCF)

Covers everyday living costs such as meals, cleaning, power, and laundry. For some residents, this is the only fee payable.



Accommodation Payment

Covers the cost of your accommodation and can be paid as a lump sum, called a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD), or as a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP). Depending on your financial assessment, the Australian Government may pay some or all of this cost on your behalf.



Hotelling Supplement

Helps cover the cost of hotel-style services such as catering, cleaning, and gardening. This supplement applies to some residents entering care from 1 November 2025, based on their income and asset assessment. DHS will advise if this applies to you and the amount payable.



Non-Clinical Care Contribution (NCCC)

Covers the cost of services such as bathing, mobility assistance, and lifestyle activities. This fee applies to some residents entering care from 1 November 2025, based on their income and asset assessment. DHS will advise if this applies to you and the amount payable.

For residents entering Residential Aged Care from 1 November 2025:

- Those choosing to pay a **Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)** will incur a 2% per year retention amount, for a maximum of five years, on the balance.
- Those choosing to pay a **Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)** will have the amount indexed twice a year at a rate determined by DHS in line with pension increases.

Payment Options

There are several ways to pay for your accommodation. You can choose the option that best suits your financial situation:

- **Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD):**
A lump sum payment, fully refundable (less any applicable retention) when you leave care.

Shared room with shared bathroom: \$475,000
Single room with shared bathroom: \$495,000
Single room with ensuite: \$525,000
- **Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP):**
A daily payment calculated based on the RAD and current MPIR. For example, for a shared room with a shared bathroom it would be \$99.03 per day.
- **Combination Payment:** A mix of RAD and DAP. For example, for a shared room with shared bathroom:
 - 50% RAD (\$237,500) + 50% DAP (\$49.52 per day)
- **RAD with Drawdown:** For example, a RAD of \$475,000 with a daily drawdown equivalent to \$49.52 in DAP charges, calculated at an interest rate of 7.61% per annum.

Note: The Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) is calculated using the Maximum Permissible Interest Rate (MPIR) set by the government. As of October 2025, the MPIR is 7.61% per annum, but this rate is updated quarterly. Please visit the Australian Government Department of Health website for the most current rates.

You may pay your accommodation as:

- A full RAD (lump sum)
- A full DAP (daily payment, billed monthly)
- A combination of both
- A drawdown from the RAD to cover DAP costs

If you move to a different room within the facility, your Residential Care Agreement will be updated to reflect the pricing of the new room. The Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) will be recalculated using the Maximum Permissible Interest Rate (MPIR) that applies on the date of your updated agreement.
